

HOLDING STATEMENT BY THE ASSOCIATION OF COMMERCIAL TELEVISION IN EUROPE ON THE COPYRIGHT DOSSIER TRILOGUE AGREEMENT

ACT takes note of the Trilogue agreement related to the Directive on Copyright in the Digital Single Market.

Despite substantial efforts by many European rights holders, the outcome is a disappointment to most members.

Therefore we call on the EU institutions to continue pursuing a real level playing field in the online space and strengthening the ability of European rights holders to create and invest in new and diverse content.
