Thomas Rabe holds a diploma and a doctorate in economics from the University of Cologne, Germany.


She holds a PhD in Law from the European University Institute in Florence and has written on media law and policy, international trade and competition law.

Named Director of the news programme in 2015, she is in charge of all the daily news shows, the investigative TV news magazine Provjereno, as well as the sports program.

Tanit Koch is a German journalist, managing director of the news channel n-tv and editor-in-chief of RTL Deutschland's central newsroom. Until 2018 she was editor-in-chief of Europe's largest newspaper BILD where she started her journalistic career in 2005 as a trainee at the politics and business desk.

Tanit Koch holds degrees in law and political science. She is a regular commentator on political affairs and information related issues on national and international media.



Sarah WhitcheadDeputy Head of Newsgathering Sky News (Sky)

Sarah Whitehead is the Deputy Head of Newsgathering at Sky New. In this role she helps to run the newsgathering department which encompasses Home, international, Specialists and political teams and looks after major events such as the wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle.

She also runs special projects which this year included Sky's ground breaking series of programmes called – Deep Ocean Live. Sky sent presenters in submersibles to the Deep Ocean to broadcast live in a broadcasting world first. This year Sky News appointed its first Climate Change correspondent and Sarah launched an environmental film strand called 'A New Climate' on Sky News. Last year Sarah sat on the EU's High Level Group on fake news and disinformation spread online. Her previous roles at Sky have included Head of Home News and Head of International News.

She joined Sky in 2011 from the BBC where she worked mostly in international news but also enjoyed stints in current affairs and drama.

Luca Rigoni Senior News Editor (Mediaset S.p.A.)

Awarded the "Amerigo Journalism Award" in 2017 in recognition of his coverage of US news, Luca was for many years the Washington political correspondent for TG5, the daily news aired on Mediaset's flagship channel Canale 5. In that time he reported back to Europe on 7 US Presidential elections and tragic events such as 9/11 and Hurricane Katrina.

After a spell working in Brussels as Editor-in-chief of the Foreign Affairs Department of Canale 5 News, he transferred to TGcom24. Today he is news anchor for TG4.

Luca studied art, music and entertainment at the Faculty of Letters and Philosophy of the University of Bologna. He wrote his thesis on the history of cinema.


