CANAL+ announces the exclusive launch-window premiere of the historical epic series KING & CONQUEROR starting February 12 in over 40 countries across Europe and Africa where the group operates. This large-scale, simultaneous multi-territory launch is a first for a series licensed by CANAL+ and illustrates the group's global strategy in licensing and launching content.

ITV has agreed a new deal with Six Nations Rugby to air major rugby competitions free-to-air until 2029, with a minimum of 124 fixtures in the next four years. ITV and STV will be the exclusive free-to-air home of the Nations Championship for fans in the UK, for its first two editions, in 2026 and 2028.

Buen Camino, the comedy co-written by and starring Checco Zalone, distributed by Medusa Film, a subsidiary of MFE, has reached an unprecedented milestone in Italian cinema history. The film has become the highest-grossing title ever at the national box

office, reaching over € 73 million revenues in just one month. Pier Silvio Berlusconi, CEO of MFE, expressed his gratitude to Zalone for an extraordinary achievement, noting that the film's success once again confirms the power of cinema to bring people together.



New Sky Original Series explores Entertainment Juggernaut, The X Factor

Sky confirmed it has greenlit a premium, definitive documentary series exploring the era-defining entertainment juggernaut, The X Factor. The documentary will speak to those closest to The X Factor story, both in front of and behind the camera, including Simon Cowell. The series is produced by award-winning independent production company 72 Films, whose hits include Grierson-winning The Zelensky Story and Emmy-winning 9/11: One Day in America and will build on Sky Documentaries' reputation for critically acclaimed unfiltered documentaries, with recent highlights including Boyzone: No Matter What, Hatton, and Klitschko: More Than a Fight.

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A new chapter begins. 'The Testaments' premières April 8th exclusively on Disney+ in the UK

Disney+ announced that the upcoming Original drama series "The Testaments," a new chapter from the showrunner and executive producers of "The Handmaid's Tale," will premiere April 8th on Disney+ in the UK with three episodes, followed by new episodes weekly. An evolution of "The Handmaid's Tale," "The Testaments" is based on Margaret Atwood's novel of the same name and is a dramatic coming-of-age story set in Gilead.
